


patterns are showing applique work, and learning how to hand applique is a wonderful skill that can be carried anywhere you go.

This one pattern has three variations of the Circle Bag, the 8-inch Circle Bag A with slide closure, the 10-inch Circle Bag B with double asymmetrical flaps, or the 12-inch Circle Bag C with the half log cabin block and slide closure. You can make the bags in one fabric, or mix and match fabrics for the bag outside, lining/reverse side, and gussets.


