We are staying in a suite at Casa del Gavilan in Cimarron on August 18. The historic inn is in the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains near Cimarron, NM. The grand adobe villa was built around 1912. It has twelve-foot high ceilings, vigas, and eighteen-inch thick walls.

Casa del Gavilan (House of the Hawk) is a showplace of Pueblo-revival architecture featuring artwork and sculptures by Frederick Remington, Charles Russell, Robert Redbird, and others.

In Santa Fe, we are staying in a suite at the Marriott, which is little way off the square. We couldn't get rooms right on the square because the 95th annual Indian Market is the weekend we are in town. The Santa Fe Indian Market® is the largest and most prestigious juried Native arts show in the world and the largest cultural event in the southwest. More than 1,100 Native artists from the U.S. and Canada sell their artwork. But the Marriott has an hourly shuttle that will take us downtown.

Opera tickets are purchased, and we are all sitting in the same row! We will take a shuttle from the hotel directly to the Opera, making it easy.
