## **Knit Pickers' Club Today! From 3-7ish**

We're checking in to see how far you've gotten on your cowl. If you didn't have a chance to come last time, come today and learn how to do our fun cowl.

We are demonstrating how to make a simple 3-stitch pattern cowl -- or at least that's how I describe it. Knit 3 purl 3 and then each row shifts over one stitch. Very simple and it can be done in any weight, any length. I will have two samples to show, one a longer one done with two yards knitted together on smaller needles and one shorter one done on bigger needles (meaning, I had less yard and it was bulkier than the other yarn).

This cowl also uses a chart, so if you have never "read" a chart, this one is the easiest one you could ever follow.

We will also talk about the next project: fingerless mitts with or without a "hood." We will talk about yarns to use, sizes, needles, etc., so you can get prepared. These mitts are knit in the round, so you will need 4-5 double pointed needles. New skill to learn, if you've never knit in the round. We'll do knit & purl stitches, increase & decreases, and ribbing. These don't take too long to make and are good Christmas gifts.
